

RoHS

The Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive banned a list of hazardous substances from all electrical and electronic equipment sold into the EU after 1st July 2006. The main substances is Lead (Pb) but there are also other substances that need to be removed (such as flame retardants used in some plastics).

To comply with these regulations it has been necessary for us to review all of the products we distribute and products shown on our website are compliant with the RoHS legislation unless otherwise stated. All paperwork specifies in product is Pb or Pb-free and has full traceability. If non-Pb-free product is essential for use outside the EU or for exempt applications within the EU, this must be specified at time of ordering.

Electrostatic Discharge Policy

In keeping with the quest for excellence in all areas of our operation, Campbell Collins has anti-static workstation procedures and maintains a static-free area in our facility. This is necessary for adequate protection from static discharge and eliminates damage or loss due to electrostatic discharge.

WEEE

The Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment Directive is intended to reduce the amount of harmful substances that are added to the environment via landfill waste disposal. It is mainly a Directive aimed at consumer goods bought at retail outlets, leaving business to business transactions to define their own means of recycling the waste products at the end of their life.

The EC has published a definitions of "finished product" that is covered by the directive that makes it clear that our products are not legally included. However, to follow the spirit of the regulations, any stock products that have reached the end of their shelf life will be processed by a specialist WEEE re-processing company who take care of recovering any useful materials and safe disposal of the remaining waste.
